Heat Tolerance ABV now more reliable

A recent update to the Heat Tolerance ABV has improved reliability of the trait in Holsteins and Jerseys.

The reliability for Holsteins increased 10 percentage points while Jerseys had a modest 1% improvement. As a result, the reranking for Heat Tolerance ABV was greater for Holsteins than Jerseys.

Heat Tolerance ABV reliability

Holsteins	38%	48%
Jerseys	38%	39%

The model for the Heat Tolerance ABV has not changed. The update involved using an expanded reference population and more SNP markers utilised in the evaluation. The expanded reference population includes records from 9,020 herds in six states.

During August and September DataGene will be holding face-to-face and online workshops with stakeholders in the herd improvement industry to discuss key learnings from the survey and interviews and implications for the National Breeding Objective. Other elements of the review process include detailed scientific and economic analysis followed by further discussion on options and recommendations. This process will be overseen by the Genetic Evaluation Standing Committee, with the view to implementation in DataGene's December 2025 public ABV release.
